Important Notes:

- 1. As of the 10th day of each semester, registration is still in progress.
- 2. 10th day census for terms prior to Spring 2011 are from morning of the following Monday.
- 10th day census for terms Spring 2011 and later are from morning of 11th day (Saturday).
- 3. FTE is calculated based on course level, not student level, per CHE reporting definitions.
- 4. Beginning in March 2016, the College Board made scoring changes to the SAT. Freshmen who entered the College since Fall 2016 may have taken either the previous version of the SAT, the new version, or both. Concordance tables provided by College Board are used to convert scores from one scale to the other. Per IPEDS-reporting requirements, the averages reported for the Fall 2016 and earlier classes are based on the older SAT scale, and the averages reported for the Fall 2017 class are based on the new scale. Comparisons across the full five years are not valid.
- 5. The College implemented the Charleston Bridge program in Fall 2017, which shifted most of the provisional students to entering in the spring semester. The number of fall-entering provisional students is less than 50.
