4. Beginning in March 2016, the College Board made scoring changes to the SAT. Freshmen who entered the College since Fall 2016 may have taken either the previous version of the SAT, or the new version, or both. Concordance tables provided by College Board are used to covert scores from one scale to the other. Per IPEDS-reporting requirements, the averages reported for the Fall 2016 and earlier classes are based on the older SAT scale, and the averages reported for the Fall 2017 class and later are based on the new scale. Comparisons across the full five years are not valid.
5. The College implemented the Charleston Bridge program in Fall 2017, which shifted most of the provisional students to entering in the spring semester. The number of fall 2018 entering provisional students was 80.
